As set out in representations in respect of Policy RDS3, there are significant concerns regarding the Council's strategy for the broad location of development. Policy RDS4 makes clear that approximately 17% of the proposed allocated housing (excluding village developments) will be located within the existing Green Belt. The Plan is clear that Green Belt should be regarded as a last resort, in circumstances where all non-Green Belt alternative sites have been exhausted. Having regarding to the Council's important Duty to Co-operate, and the need to meet the full objectively assessed housing needs, the Council should consider alternative non-Green Belt sites, not only within their administrative boundary, but also in relation to neighbouring authorities. One such alternative option available is to consider less sensitive Green Belt release; alternatively to direct housing to meet Warwick District's housing requirements in a sustainable manner. This approach would avoid the need for the release the significant tract of land on the edge of Kenilworth which is presently being identified for 700 dwellings.
