I object as follows:-

- 1) Too many of the sites are in or adjoining the Parish of Bishops Tachbrook, 6 out of a possible 20 options, with Site No 4 on the edge of the Parish Bdy.
- 2) There are no options shown around Kenilworth town, whilst it is in the green belt there must be small brown field areas which could accommodate 5 Caravans either for transit or permanent use. A fair spread of sites through out the district is required, without the difficulties of building in the green belt being used as an excuse to fairly allocate sites.
- 3) If 31 permanent pitches are required they should not exceed 8 pitches/site and transit sites 4/pitches/site. These should be allocated through out the district and not in & around Bishops Tachbrook.
- 4) Too many sites in Bishops Tachbrook will overstretch the capacity of the village School & Surgery.

A fair spread of sites through out the district is required without the difficulties of building in the green belt being used as an excuse to fairly allocate sites.
- 3) If 21 permanent sites are required they should not exceed 8 sites/ sites and transit sites 4/ houses/ these should be allocated through out the district and not as around Bishop's Tactbook.
- 4) Too many sites in Bishop's Tactbook will overstretch the capacity of the village school & nursery.

- 5) Sites in and around Bishops Tachbrook
- a) Sites 3 & 4 - remote from major amenities
  - b) Site 5 - Access onto a very busy road. No pedest - Main access. Potential visual impact on the approach to Historic Warwick. Listed building on the site.
  - c) Site 6 - remote from main centres, no means of pedestrian access.
  - d) site 9 - access onto a very busy road. No pedestrian access. Potential visual impact on the approach to Historic Warwick. Listed buildings on the site.
  - e) Site 10. Too close to Guide Dogs for the Blind National Breeding Centre. could cause disruption to the breeding.
  - f) Site 15. - Site on the bank of the Tachbrook, therefore there could be a chance of pollution from on site businesses. Too close to Europa Way, access would be dangerous
- 6) All sites where ever located MUST be managed by Warwick D.C. and NOT the G + T's themselves. All sites/pitches must be made to pay Council tax and/or fees for upkeep & ~~mountain~~ maintenance.
- 7) It would be better to locate all possible sites on the edge of Industrial Parks closer to Towns.

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
