<ul> <li>Safe access to the road network and provision for parking, turning and servicing on site;</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Avoiding areas where there is the potential for noise and other disturbance;</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Provision of utilities (running water, toilet facilities, waste disposal, etc);</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Avoiding areas where there could be adverse impact on important features of the natural and historic environment; and,</li> </ul>
- Sites which can be integrated into the landscape without harming the character of the area.
<ul> <li>Promotes peaceful and integrated co-existence between the site and the local community;</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Avoids placing undue pressure on local infrastructure and services;</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Reflects the extent to which traditional lifestyles (whereby some travellers live and work from the same location thereby omitting many travel to work journeys) can contribute to sustainability.</li> </ul>
