

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The policy in the Draft Local Plan will list the criteria by which Gypsy and Traveller sites will be judged for suitability and sustainability. These are the criteria:

- Convenient access to a GP surgery, school and public transport;
- Avoiding areas with a high risk of flooding;
- Safe access to the road network and provision for parking, turning and servicing on site;
- Avoiding areas where there is the potential for noise and other disturbance;
- Provision of utilities (running water, toilet facilities, waste disposal, etc);
- Avoiding areas where there could be adverse impact on important features of the natural and historic environment; and,
- Sites which can be integrated into the landscape without harming the character of the area.
- Promotes peaceful and integrated co-existence between the site and the local community;
- Avoids placing undue pressure on local infrastructure and services;
- Reflects the extent to which traditional lifestyles (whereby some travellers live and work from the same location thereby omitting many travel to work journeys) can contribute to sustainability.

- There is no GP surgery in the vicinity.
- The area is at medium risk of flooding
- This site would not provide safe access to the road network and/or village. The access to the site would involve having to cross the bypass to gain entry to the site - the road having a 60mph limit; far from safe.
- This is a beautiful area of unspoilt natural beauty; the site would have a considerable impact

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on the unspoilt landscape, would be immediately visible & would drastically impact on the area visually. Such a site would, without question, harm the character of the area.

- This area is a peaceful & unspoilt area & the introduction of such a site would unquestionably spoil that.

- This area has Grade 2 agricultural land, the farmer does not wish to sell it & to force such a sale & such a dramatic change to the use of the land would be devastating to the local community (& further reaching than that), would affect the usual impact of the area & would spoil the natural beauty of the land - this includes the protected species here (Water Voles) & the fact that only relatively recently Bronze Age burial sites were found here which need to be protected.

- The introduction of such a site in this area would be devastating to local small business & to the mood & spirit of a beautiful community & area.
