In response to the 'DRAFT GYPSY & TRAVELLERS SITE OPTIONS' that WARWICK DISTRICT COUNCIL are proposing I object strongly to the sites selected close to the boundaries of BISHOPS TACHBROOK.

As a resident of Bishops Tachbrook since 1979 these proposals would present many problems in the future.

The local school is already running at capacity levels and more pressures in numbers would only create problems. The current local traffic at peak periods is already a problem especially accessing the BANBURY ROAD and OAKLYWOOD ROAD.

I have witnessed myself the terrible upheaval and disgusting mess these TRAVELLERS and GYPSIES leave behind when they finally decide to move on.

Case in question, the access road to TRIDENT COURAGE and the roads behind the trading units off TACHBROOK PARK DRIVE, also the playing fields off Harkbury Lane.
