We wish to register our concern about the possible Traveller sites close to the Forse Way. With public owned land available it seems a waste of tax payers money to compulsorily purchase land. Is using land outside the green belt setting a dangerous precedent? Are brown field sites not more appropriate?

As retired senior partner of the General Practice in Marking, I wonder if the existing facilities would cope with the influx.

The areas around the Forse Way are a beautiful part of Middle England; a Traveller site would be a blot on the landscape.

Traffic at rush hours on the Forse Way is very busy, and crossing from Marking at present is very difficult, this can only be exacerbated by further residences.
