The policy in the Draft Local Plan will list the criteria by which Gypsy and Traveller sites will be judged for suitability and sustainability. These are the criteria:

- Convenient access to a GP surgery, school and public transport;
- Avoiding areas with a high risk of flooding;
- Safe access to the road network and provision for parking, turning and servicing on site;
- Avoiding areas where there is the potential for noise and other disturbance;
- Provision of utilities (running water, toilet facilities, waste disposal, etc);
- Avoiding areas where there could be adverse impact on important features of the natural and historic environment; and,
- Sites which can be integrated into the landscape without harming the character of the area.
- Promotes peaceful and integrated co-existence between the site and the local community;
- Avoids placing undue pressure on local infrastructure and services;
- Reflects the extent to which traditional lifestyles (whereby some travellers live and work from the same location thereby omitting many travel to work journeys) can contribute to sustainability.

1. WESTHAM LANE IS A SINGLE TRACK LANE, THERE IS NO PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY... IT WOULD NEED TO BE WIDENED & A CPO WOULD BE REQUIRED. OWNERSHIP IS UNKNOWN THERE WOULD BE LOSS OF HEDGE ROWS, LANDSCAPE AND NEGATIVE VISUAL EFFECTS. AGRICULTURAL LAND IS GRADE 2 LISTED WHICH SHOULD NOT BE DEVELOPED IF THE FARMER DOES NOT WANT TO SELL... A CPO WOULD BE NEEDED. WATER VOLES ARE PRESENT (A PROTECTED SPECIES). DURING BUILDING THE BY-PASS, BRONZE AGE BURIAL SITES WERE FOUND... AS THE SITE IS HISTORICAL, IT IS EXCLUDED FROM DEVELOPMENT.
2. ACCESS TO WESTHAM LANE IS DANGEROUS, TRAFFIC MOVES PAST. THERE IS NO CROSSING TO VILLAGE WHICH IS VERY DANGEROUS.
3. THERE ARE NO STORM/POUL SEWERS WEST OF BY-PASS. AREA IS MEDIUM FLOOD RISK. NO GP IN VILLAGE. LANDSCAPE IS IDILIC, THIS WOULD BE SPOILT.
4. IT TOOK 2 YEARS FOR OWNERS OF WESTHAM HOUSE TO BE GRANTED PERMISSION TO MOVE INTERNAL WALLS DUE TO LOCATION, IT WOULD BE WRONG FOR WPC TO GRANT A G+T SITE AT THE END OF THEIR LANE.
5. WDC HAVE DISREGARDED THEIR OWN RAP NEW HOUSING, NEW EMPLOYMENT, SAFEGUARDING RURAL ROADS AND CAMPING + CARAVAN SITES. PUTTING G+T SITES WOULD BE A CONTRADICTION TO THEIR POLICIES.
6. PUTTING A G+T SITE HERE WOULD AFFECT PROPERTY PRICES, HAVE A NEGATIVE AFFECT ON THE VILLAGE AND CAUSE NOISE AND DISTURBANCES.
