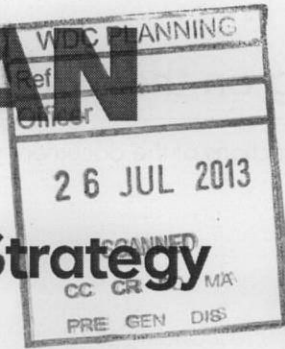

For Kingswood (Lapworth) the proposed planning is far too large for the parish of Lapworth, never mind a particular area of Lapworth.

A smaller number of dwellings spread over the whole parish of Lapworth would be more appropriate, in particular developments near to the Lapworth/Hockley Heath boundary on the Aylesbury Road & Old Warwick Road would only be a small incremental increase to the conurbation of Hockley Heath. Also development around the boundaries of Lapworth/Dorridge would build on the infrastructural strengths that Dorridge has to offer.

Kingswood has already a high density of population within Lapworth and any significant increase in housing in the Kingswood area of Lapworth risks bringing urban sprawl to the rural setting of the Lapworth parish. If Lapworth railway station is being taken as the reason that Kingswood has the infrastructure to support a large number of new dwellings then one look at the railway timetable for Lapworth would show that this is not the case.

Notwithstanding the above comments, if Kingswood has to take a number of new dwellings then they should be in small clusters rather than a ribbon development which could create urban sprawl in rural Warwickshire.
