The allocation for development of Kingswood/Lapworth as a Primary Service Village is wrong for a number of reasons but in my opinion for one principle reason.

Compared with other villages in the group: (Bishops Tachbrook, Cublington, Hampton Magna, and Radford Somele) Lapworth suffers Primary Service in Hospital/Ambulance, and Police security presence.

See map 2 page 24, Lapworth stands out as isolated compared with the other villages in the group.

The best emergency call out times we can expect is about 20 minutes whereas the other villages are grouped close to Llanwicks/Llanymington.

Committing 100-150 more houses to these further sites seems wrong
