Dear Sir,

I write in protest to the proposals in the revised Development Strategy, in order to protect Warwick from

1. Further traffic congestion. I was stuck for 1¼ hours in a jam at the "Morvian" roundabout.
- The failure of the Banbury Road bridge which cannot sustain more traffic - weight. Traffic at the Castle Entrance roundabout causing back up jams down the Banbury and Myton Roads and up Castle Hill.
2. Waste disposal failure from too many buildings
3. Flooding, very possible from the river if water is channelled down from buildings up the Banbury Road.
- 4. Overload at the Hospital from increased population.
5. Greater air pollution, already dangerous, more traffic = worsening air quality
