The policy in the Draft Local Plan will list the criteria by which Gypsy and Traveller sites will be judged for suitability and sustainability. These are the criteria:

- 1 - Convenient access to a GP surgery, school and public transport;
 - 2 - Avoiding areas with a high risk of flooding;
 - 3 - Safe access to the road network and provision for parking, turning and servicing on site;
 - 4 - Avoiding areas where there is the potential for noise and other disturbance;
- Provision of utilities (running water, toilet facilities, waste disposal, etc);
 - Avoiding areas where there could be adverse impact on important features of the natural and historic environment; and,
 - Sites which can be integrated into the landscape without harming the character of the area.
 - Promotes peaceful and integrated co-existence between the site and the local community;
 - Avoids placing undue pressure on local infrastructure and services;
 - Reflects the extent to which traditional lifestyles (whereby some travellers live and work from the same location thereby omitting many travel to work journeys) can contribute to sustainability.

Based on criteria set out above

1. There is no convenient access to GPs, schools or transport. The only access is by direct entry/exit to and from an extremely busy first moving dual carriageway - A46 - in one direction only.
2. There have been two incidents of flooding to the lane running adjacent to A46 in past 10 months when sandbags were deployed along A46 by Highways Agency. Area is natural low point.
3. The A46 must represent a serious danger to any children or animals on site. There is no pedestrian access for school-age children to safely travel to and from local schools.
4. Constant traffic noise from A46 has provoked complaints as far away as Hampton Magna - it would be unimaginable to actually live alongside it.

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
