

Potential Sites for Gypsies and Travellers - Public Consultation

I refer to your recent letter regarding potential sites for occupation by gypsies and travellers and, in particular, the land to the west side of Cubbington Hill Farm in Leicester Lane, Cubbington (ref. GT08).

This area is owned by the Cubbington Freeholders which is a registered charity and administered by Trustees. Originally it was a quarry and was awarded to the Trustees through Commissioners who were appointed to administer the Inclosure Award for the Parish of Cubbington dated 12th February 1768.

The site is currently leased to Warwickshire County Council as a storage depot and the rental is the sole income that the charity receives.

The charity is very active and provides grants for the 'good and benefit of the community and community based organisations within the Parish of Cubbington'. In accordance with this objective, over the past ten years we have been pleased to make grants totalling £107,239 to support the activities of a wide variety of local organisations.
