Dear Sir,

I have looked at the Gypsies and Travellers site options Response Form and I consider that the majority of the public have not had adequate time to visit all the sites and make a reasoned sensible decision. I consider that a compulsory purchase of a site is wrong, particularly for this group of people who often behave in an antisocial way. Purchase of farmland would undoubtedly lead to the removal of local fences, hedges and trees for firewood and the loss of livestock.

English travellers or those that have regularly travelled in Warwickshire and are of good character should be financially helped and asked to provide some money themselves to buy their own sites. These sites must be granted planning permission by the local authorities before purchase.

Ideally these sites should not be too close to residential areas, but should be near industrial estates where the gypsies could work on their own premises without causing nuisance.
