

Following the Parish Meeting last night I just have general comments to make, which I hope will be helpful.

I consider the number of houses suggested to be added to Leek Wootton (about 85, I believe) would constitute too high a proportion to be added. A smaller proportion of the existing number of dwellings in Leek Wootton would be acceptable - indeed, probably beneficial.

Wherever the new housing is built, access onto any existing roads in the village would need to be considered very carefully. Access onto Warwick Road by the Anchor Inn would require traffic lights or some other form of control.

If No. 10 site was built on, access through the small paddock onto Home Farm (part of which I own) would be undesirable and possibly dangerous onto the main road opposite (almost) Hill Wootton Road.

My objection is the quantity of housing, as being too much.
