

You can see from the map of Radford Seneca has densely populated the rest of the village is compared to site 1, therefore we feel the houses should be built on site 1 where they can be accommodated easier. Because the rest of the village is more densely populated it already suffers from traffic congestion, particularly on School Lane at peak times. There is also a problem of surface water & drainage on School Lane & there are signs of it spilling onto the road after heavy rain. Additional housing on this part of the village would worsen the problem further.

It is also important to protect the village from merging with Leamington Spa, taking this into account & all of the other problems already mentioned, we most definitely do not want the houses to be built on site 4. We feel this is where it would have the most negative impact.

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
