- I strongly object to Option 1 because.
- 1/ Contrary to the requirements for growth in Warwickshire, villages, we do not have local services.
 - a) There are no travel connections to get to work.
 - b) There is no daily bus service.
 - c) To access any services i.e. doctor, shops, library the only option is to go by car.
 - 2/ Option 1 is the furthest area from Tile Hill Station so why not choose a site nearer the station and buses
 - 3/ Burton Green School will not be able to accommodate the anticipated rise in pupil numbers if as many as 75 homes are to be built.
 - 4/ There has been no thought as to how the devastation caused by HS2 will impact that area.
 - 5/ The access points to the new development will create traffic congestion particularly near the school.

The other Options were rejected for the following reasons:

- 1/ Poor and limited access - Options 2, 6 & 7.
 - 2/ Out of character with surrounding area - Option 2
 - 3/ Significant impact on landscape character - Options 3 & 4
 - 4/ Elevated location with high landscape impact - Option 5.
- Option 1 is the highest elevation.

Every single one of these objections applies to Option 1.

- A large isolated settlement is completely out of character with the area and will destroy the cohesiveness of the village.
- Why does Burton Green have to have a 28% increase in housing, much higher than any other village in the county? This will create a village within a village.
