Dear Sir

I write in response to the consultation on the WDC Local Plan regarding housing development proposals for Burda Green.

- I support the Burrow Hill nursery site, and the opportunity it provides to support the School. However, the number of houses needs to be re-examined and reduced from the currently proposed 75.

- I support the development of a second site, in parallel to Burrow Hill, at Option 2 - land to the rear of the Peeping Tom. whilst land at Burrow Hill could be used to support the School with a playing field and parking, Option 2 could provide a home for a new village hall and an opportunity to redevelop the Peeping Tom

into a pub more in keeping with
the village, thus supporting 'the
retention and development of local services
and community facilities' (WDC Local Plan
page 9)

If this dual development
meant we in fact had more than our
'allocated' 75 houses, perhaps we
could be fire proofed from developments
in future years.
