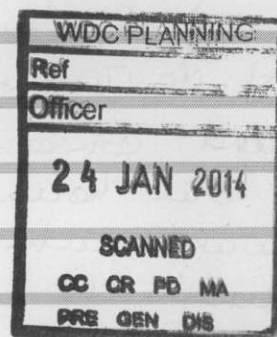

We are concerned that option 2 is a totally unsuitable choice for house building. As you will be aware, the surface water from Cromwell Lane is piped underground through No 170, and into the large pond adjacent to that property.

Apart from the important fact that this pond and the field were attractive to the recent buyers of No 170, in the winter the pond becomes very full and consequently the field is always very wet.

Our house is close to this field and we have water which drains from it, including that which finds its way to the ditch in the next field, which overflows and floods down the side of our property.

The pipe which should take this down the field to a soakaway is too small and totally inadequate.

In addition there is a great variety of wildlife living in the pond which would be harmful to the many species to disturb - including great crested newts and other pond life, dragon flies, herons etc. Many small birds nest in the hedges which are also home to pheasants, the occasional partridge and muntjac deer.

We have studied all the options and agree that option 1 fulfils all the requirements you mention, particularly as a link to join Red Lane, the School and Hob Lane to the rest of Burton Green.
