As a long term resident of the village I have two problems with the proposed development next to St. Nicholas church.

This site area has been an iconic marker for the village over centuries and has come to represent Radford Semele to generations of villagers and non residents alike. Recently I made a dvd of the history of the church and came to recognise how the site has been cherished since Anglo Saxon times and how much it had come to mean to the present community. The sight identifies Radford Semele like no other. This open area on the entrance/exit to the village is vital to maintain the village's identity.

My second objection to this plan centres on the problem of traffic. Those of us who live in the village know that traffic through the village has become a major problem and increasingly dangerous. Traffic on to, and off the Southam Road from Offchurch Lane, School Lane and Kingshurst is <u>already</u> a problem because of the increased through traffic. At certain times it is impossible to join the heavy traffic to and from these roads, and the frustration caused is inviting errors of judgement and the potential for accidents. Whichever exit from the proposed site might be chosen, it would mean an increase to these problems and affect the lives of existing villagers.

I cannot conceive of a worse place for a development in this village.

I would also like to comment on the poor way the process of consultation has been managed by WDC. It appears that our local representatives have been kept substantially in the dark in recent times and their ability to keep the village informed has been impaired. Details of the plan have only been available for a very short time to residents.

The short period of consultation has therefore been made shorter than would be thought to be reasonable for such an important decision.
