
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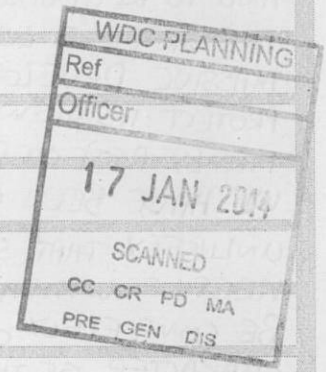

IT IS ALREADY DIFFICULT TO TURN OUT OF OFFCHURCH LANE AND SCHOOL LANE. ANY ADDITIONAL ACCESS ROADS (OR INCREASED TRAFFIC IN CHURCH LANE) WOULD BE HIGHLY DANGEROUS AND CAUSE UNACCEPTABLE LEVELS OF POLLUTION TO SURROUNDING RESIDENCES. OFFCHURCH LANE AND THE SOUTHAM ROAD ARE MAJOR COMMUTER ROUTES AND THE ADDITIONAL TRAFFIC CONTROLS WHICH WOULD BE REQUIRED WOULD ENCOURAGE GRIDLOCK AND ACCIDENTS. I HAVE SEEN NO STUDIES OF CARBON MONOXIDE LEVELS, OR DAMAGE TO BUILDINGS AROUND THE FIELDS BY THE CHURCH ARE VITAL TO THE IDENTITY OF THE VILLAGE, AND TO RETAINING THE IMPRESSION OF SEPARATION FROM LEAMINGTON SPA. THE GRADE II LISTING OF THE CHURCH SHOULD ALSO PRECLUDE SUCH A MASSIVE DEVELOPMENT RIGHT NEXT TO IT: THE COUNCIL HAS A DUTY TO PROTECT ITS VIEWS. DEVELOPMENT IN THIS AREA HAS PREVIOUSLY BEEN FIRMLY REJECTED AND IT WOULD BE NEGLIGENT TO OVERTURN THIS RULING. WE HAVE BEEN GIVEN LITTLE DETAIL OF THE DEVELOPMENT, BUT IT SEEMS UNLIKELY THAT SO MANY HOUSES IN SUCH A SMALL SPACE WOULD BE KEEPING WITH THE SURROUNDING AREA: A HOUSING ESTATE HERE WOULD BE COMPLETELY OUT OF PLACE AND PERMANENTLY DESTROY THE CHARACTER OF THE VILLAGE. THE HOUSES IN THE BROCHURE LOOK HIDEOUS! THE PARISH COUNCIL HAVE NOT BEEN CONSULTED ABOUT THIS SITE - THEY HAD ALREADY PROPOSED AN ALTERNATIVE. VILLAGERS HAVE NOT BEEN CONSULTED AT ALL, HAVING TO RELY ON NEIGHBOURS TO PROVIDE INFORMATION. WHY HAVE THE COUNCIL GIVEN NO ALTERNATIVE? THIS IS NOT CONSULTATION - IT'S IMPOSITION!

THE FIELDS ARE NECESSARY FOR DRAINAGE. BOTH OFFCHURCH LANE AND SCHOOL LANE HAVE PREVIOUSLY FLOODED, AND THE PROPOSED BUILDINGS WOULD MAKE IT WORSE.

THE COUNCIL'S PREFERRED OPTION (1) MUST BE REJECTED. OPTION 2 IS THE ONLY POSSIBILITY WITH FEWER HOUSES

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
