


I would prefer it if this potential development does not mean the loss of the Allotment land off the Rugby Road. The re-location of the allotments may not be in an area which is convenient for the Allotment Holders and in any case will take more Green Belt land. I consider that the holders of allotments should be supported and not made to pay the price for this development by losing their established sites. To resolve this issue may I suggest that the development opposite Willow Sheets Meadow be extended northwards towards Oakdene on the Coventry Road to accommodate the houses which would have been built off Rugby Road and therefore protecting the existing allotments.

May I also question why the new development of small affordable homes intended for local people has been excluded from this project.
