Objections to Site No.1

The Church and surrounding buildings are listed and it is the duty of the Council to protect that setting.

The type, allocation and density of housing required is inappropriate for this setting of a listed building.

The proposed Gladman site retains the same characteristics already firmly rejected by the Council as part of its own detailed planning analysis.

The Vehicular Access suggestions are quite unsuitable in every way. If this site is to be developed, with provision for access of some 200 cars, it will need an access road from a new round-about sited on the junction of Offchurch Road and Southam Road, with appropriate pedestrian facilities.

Any development of the site will increase the drainage issues already faced by the village. The land of Site No.1 acts as a natural drainage area for houses on Offchrch Road and other nearby dwellings. This valuable natural drainage area provides protection from polluted flood water draining into the natural aquifers of the G.U.Canal and the River Leam.

No.1 site leaves no provision for future planning needs, as accepted in WDC's Local Plan. Sites 2 & 3 (Taylor Woodrow) would provide this.
