- JONERNMENT GUIDELINES SPECIFICALLY STATE
 THERE HAVE TO BE "VERY SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES"
 TO USE GREENBELT SITES. NO ONE ATALL IS
 AWARE OF ANY JUSTIFICATION TO OPEN SUCH A
 SITE AT OAKLANDS FARM.
- THE SITE IS IN FULL VIEW ON THE MAIN A 417Y ROUTE INTO HISTORIC WARWICK. THIS WILL CREATE A NEGATIVE IMPACT ON TOURISM AND SPOIL THE OPENHESS OF THE AREA. S'CREENING OFF WOULD NOT HIDE A SITE OR LESSEN NOISE IT WOULD JUST SERVE TO DRAW UNWELCOME ATTENTION AND CHANGE / RUIN THE LANDSCAPE.
- THE SITE LOCATION IS ON A WELL NOTED ACCIDENT BLACKSPOT ROUTE (A4147) WITH ITS ENTRANCE AT THE EXTREMELY BUSY & DANGEROUS JUNCTION OF UGLY BRIDGE ROAD SHELL PETROL STATION MORE FATAL ACCIDENTS AND SEVERE TRAFFIC PROBLEMS ARE GUARANTEED.
- THE TIGHT KNIT COMMUNITY OF THE FEW LOCAL RESIDENTS NEAREST THE SITE WOULD BE OVERWHELMED & OUTNOMBERED. THIS WOULD NOT PROMOTE A PEACEFUL & INTEGRATED. CO-EXISTENCE AT ALL.
- THE DANGERS OF DEEP WATER, NEARBY RAILWAY LINE, A VERY FAST & DANGEROUS ROAD WITH VERY CLOSE PROXIMITY TO A 24 HOUR PETROL STATION ALONG WITH THE EFFECT ON CANALY TOWPATH USERS / TOURISM FOR HATTON LOCKS, THE DETRIMENT TO THE ECOLOGY, WILDLIFE and all LOCAL FARMLAND CLEARLY PRESENTS NUMEROUS AND VERY STRONG REASONS TO OPPOSE THIS SITE.
