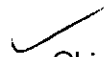

I WISH TO REGISTER VERY STRONG OBJECTION TO INCLUSION OF SITE GTalt 03 IN YOUR CONSULTATION DOC. THIS SITE IS WITHIN THE GREEN BELT AND IN THE LAST FIVE YEARS HAS BEEN THE SUBJECT OF 2 PLANNING REFUSALS BY THE WDC PLANNING COMMITTEE IN 2009 AND 2011. ON EACH OCCASION THE PARISH COUNCILLORS ALAN RHEAD (2009) AND CLARE SANDOZ (2011) SUPPORTED LOCAL RESIDENTS IN THEIR OBJECTIONS. THE SITE HAS ALSO BEEN DISMISSED BY PLANNING INSPECTORS AT AN APPEAL IN 2009 AND AFTER THAT IN 2010 THE WDC TOOK OUT AN INJUNCTION TO PREVENT ANY DEVELOPMENT. THE CONDITIONS THAT APPLIED THEN ARE STILL VALID AND RELEVANT TODAY. IT IS THEREFORE INCONCEIVABLE THAT IT SHOULD BE GIVEN ANY CONSIDERATION BY THE UDAY AUTHORITY THAT REFUSED THOSE APPLICATIONS. HAMPTON ON THE HILL IS NOT IDENTIFIED WITHIN EITHER THE ADOPTED WDC LOCAL PLAN (2006) OR WITHIN THE DRAFT 'VILLAGE HOUSING OPTIONS' CONSULTATION AS A SUSTAINABLE LOCATION FOR ANY NEW RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT. AS SUCH IT IS ALSO NOT A SUSTAINABLE LOCATION FOR A TRAVELLER SITE. I THEREFORE REQUEST THAT THE SITE GTalt 03 BE RECLASSIFIED AS A BRED SITE AND REMOVED FROM ANY CONSIDERATION IN THIS CONSULTATION
