Planning Application W/14/0618: Common Lane, Kenilworth (Crackley Triangle)

I wish to oppose this application, which presents a major threat to the Crackley area.

In their documentation, the applicants claim to be following the objectives of the Local Plan, for example, 'to protect and enhance the natural environment' (2.3.1.1). It is true that the site is not in the Green Belt, but it is a vital part of the much-valued 'Green Wedge' separating Kenilworth from Coventry. There is no way that building 93 houses on it protects or enhances the environment: quite the reverse.

To provide access to the site, 'a proposed three arm signalised junction' is said to be 'acceptable' to WCC Highways Dept – most disturbingly. The applicants claim that this will 'improve the safety of Common Lane'. It is hard to see how bringing out the traffic from 93 houses on to the already much-used Common Lane will improve its safety. And the proposed three-way signals will inevitably create huge tailbacks to Coventry Road and Dalehouse Lane.

Under 'Structure Maintenance Requirements, there is a suggestion that 'emergency access' might involve access along the Greenway adjacent to the site. This is wholly unacceptable. The Greenway has been an immense popular success with local residents, and is much used. To bring vehicles on to a pedestrian/cycle way would be to destroy it.

The construction work on the site itself, with all its noise and disturbance, together with the work on the three-way signals and on the proposed alterations to the railway bridge, will create major disruption for local residents.

So on environmental grounds, on those of safety, and on general amenity, I ask the Council to reject this application.
