	 There are two main modifications affecting Hampton Magna that I wish to object to: Allocation of land (H51) South of Lloyd Close for 115 homes Increase in housing density to the land (H27) South of Arras Boulevard from 100 to 130 homes
	My reasons for objection are as follows: Character of the village, which currently has a unique character and feel and would be adversely affected by such a large increase in new homes. Also the character of the landscape around it, the setting of the village. A decrease in useable open space for leisure activities; fields are used regularly by local residents for walking.
	Access – roads into the village narrow to one track in parts, increase in traffic would increase congestion.
	Congestion – in and out of the village, but also the area around the shop/post office, medical centre & school. Parking is already limited and school drop off/pick up times are very congested and busy.
	Safety – local children currently play in the streets within the village itself, this would become dangerous with an increase in traffic.
	Pressure on existing services and community facilities. Only one small shop, plus school and medical centre.
	Train station also at capacity at peak hours.
