7. Please give details of why you consider the Proposed Modifications to the Submission Warwick District Local Plan are not legally compliant or are unsound. Please be as precise as possible. If you wish to support the legal compliance or soundness of the Proposed Modifications, please also use this box to set out your comments. High performing Green Belt land should not be changed to building land becuase: 1) The exceptional circumstances to remove this land from Green Belt have not been demonstrated. 2) There are low and medium performing green belt land that should take priority - if land is to be removed from Green Belt. 3) The justificiation is that the land is required for additional housing for Coventry, but is not near Coventry and will therefore increase commuting adding traffic, conjestion, pollution and wasted communting time. Housing for Coventry should be as close as possible to Coventry. 4) The additional development will increase car usage considerably adding problems to an already over capacity road infrastructure in the North Leamington Spa. 5) There appears to be enough parking currently in Leamington and certainly not enough of a problem to justify a full park and ride scheme. Please set out what change(s) you consider necessary to make the Proposed Modifications to the Submission Warwick District Local Plan legally compliant or sound, having regard to the test you have identified at Question 5 above where this relates to soundness. The Park and Ride proposal will only be used by people travelling significant distance to Leamington. i.e. on the North of Leamington this means the A46. Therefore it makes more sense to have them park as soon as possible after leaving the A46 to reduce traffic and pollution. If it were close to the A46 / A452 junction then it would also serve Kenilworth. It would also require a regular bus service (at least once every 15 mins in peak hours) to make it convenient to use.
