7. Please give details of why you consider the Proposed Modifications to the Submission Warwick District Local Plan are not legally compliant or are unsound. Please be as precise as possible. If you wish to support the legal compliance or soundness of the Proposed Modifications, please also use this box to set out your comments. Consultation of the huge numbers of houses planned now was not made known in an appropriate time with the residents of Finham who are most affected by this proposal. It has not been shown by Coventry City Council that they have explored the many brown field sites in the city area before suggesting a beautiful green field site, which is working farmland, which will be destroyed if this development proceeds. This area is also home to many species of animal including bats, badgers, crested newts and is also a source of drinking water. The infrastructure in this area is under strain at the moment, such a huge increase in the number of people living here will require road improvements around the whole of the new development which would have to take account of the protected hedgerows along Green Lane. Sewage and water removal from properties would have to be improved and the local disposal plant upgraded to cope with the heavier demand with confirmation that the River Sowe can also cope with the heavier demand especially at the times of flooding which is more common nowadays. The local community of Finham will be dwarfed by this number of new housing on its doorstep. It is disproportionate with the housing currently existing, more than trebling the housing stock. A new development would need extensive planning and consideration for current roads, new roads, drainage, sewage, underground pipelines, new power lines, schools, libraries, community centre and fit in with the surroundings.
