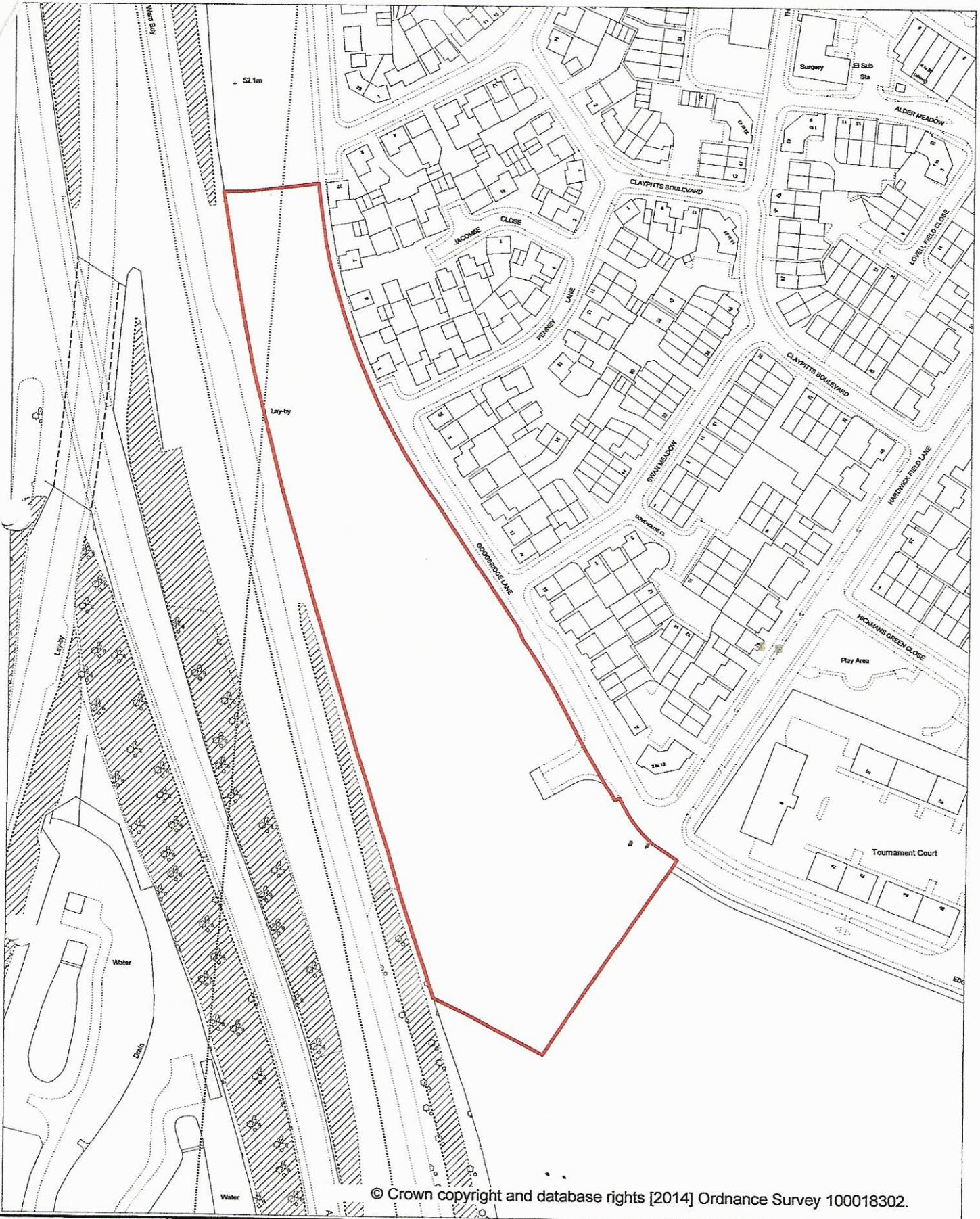
Question 7

The Modifications propose the further release of Green Belt land around Leamington and Warwick at 'Land North of Milverton'. The release of Green Belt land is not justified when my client's land at Goggbidge Lane (see attached plan) is available for residential development. This land is ideally placed for residential development as it lies directly opposite existing housing. Moreover, Goggbidge Lane is a residential estate road, unsuitable for commercial traffic. The site is therefore unsuitable for Class B2 / B89 employment land but is very well-related to a well-established residential community.

We refer to the recent approval for the residential redevelopment of the Opus 40 employment site (planning application W15/0646 for 85 dwellings) where the District Council accepted that suitable noise mitigation could be achieved, despite the site's proximity to the adjacent A46. In the light of this, we are unaware of any reason why appropriate noise mitigation could not also be achieved on the land at Goggbidge Lane.

Question 8

The allocation of land at Goggbidge Lane for residential development (we estimate that the 5 acre site could accommodate approximately 50 dwellings) would make the Plan 'sound' by being consistent with the NPPF guidance that Green Belt boundaries should only be revised in exceptional circumstances, which implies that this should be in cases where there are no other suitable sites available.
