

Dear Sir,

I feel very strongly about the unacceptable pressures that the above proposed development, on green belt land, will put on our existing services and community facilities.

I travel to and from Hampton Magna twice daily and I'm very aware, often horrified, at the constant, dangerous, overcrowded conditions of the 3 narrow, twisting roads serving the area - not to mention the "blind summit" at Hampton-on-the-Hill!! "Rat-runs" of speeding cars, drivers late for brains and parents on school runs - all mindless of local traffic,

buses or a 30 mph limit!

When Warwick Parkway was built, (car parks here are now at full capacity level), we were told that traffic would approach it from the A46/A4177 - this has certainly not happened, drivers head for Longbridge via Old Budnose Road.

The local school is unable to cope with a large intake that such a development is bound to create; similarly the G.P. facilities, both already serve a larger area than the immediate one.

We have lived here for 40 years and consider this proposal to be a terrible error - rushed through with no regard for the consequences on cramped, existing facilities

The whole character of the area, various species and habitats will be lost.
