It is my understanding that this land is also part of the flood risk area. Since I moved to Hatton the field has been constantly waterlogged (as has parts of my garden). I do not think the land is suitable for housing development. If new housing were to go ahead, what effect would it have on the current balancing tank? Who would undertake a risk assessment? | |
| | My second major concern is the Birmingham Road. I have to use this road at peak times of the morning and evening and it is apparent that volumes of traffic often lead to severe delays which has a knock-on effect with an increase in pollution. In order to get my son to school on time I am finding that we have to leave home by 0745 (& even then it can take 40+ minutes to get to the Myton Road). Warwick town centre already struggles with the volume of traffic, this will only make it much worse. Building more houses will not ameliorate the situation, only worsen it. | |
