The area H50 is all green belt and Government policy, as set out in the National Planning Policy Framework, is that green belt boundaries should only be altered in exceptional circumstances. The modifications do not set out any exceptional circumstances that justify removing this land from green belt.
The modifications to the local plan acknowledge that the flooding risk of surface drainage water from the H50 fields

The modifications to the local plan acknowledge that the flooding risk of surface drainage water from the H50 fields will require a significant new drainage to be employed if the houses in the lower parts of Cubbington, such as New Street are not to be flooded. These houses have been flooded in the past and while the recent flood alleviation measures are currently working these will be overwhelmed with the addition of such a substantial number of additional houses and roadways. This situation will be further exacerbated by the loss of woodland with the construction of HS2 which currently aids the absorption of surface water. There is no evidence of a thorough examination of the impact of surface water flooding within the amended local plan. This will put a significant number of existing households at increased risk. See attached photos on continuation sheet.

The proposed H50 development will have a detrimental impact on the landscape to the east of Cubbington which will be in addition to the already proposed impact on landscape due to the construction of HS2.

The number of homes proposed for site H50 will require a road access from the B4453 close to the embankment to the road bridge over the HS2 line causing a potential traffic hazard due to reduced visibility and increased volume of
