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Representation on Modifications 14 and 16 to the Local Plan

The Exceptional Circumstances required by the National Planning Framework to remove the land north of Milverton from the Green Belt have not been demonstrated.

The proposed development is more concerned with Coventry City Council's housing need than for the protection of the Green Belt. Furthermore, land on the edge of Coventry is of lower Green Belt value and should be used in preference to land north of Milverton which has high agricultural value and quality wild life habitat. As a consequence of the proposal the "green lung" between Leamington Spa and Kenilworth will be reduced hence a coalescence of the two towns. Property values and the cost of living are substantially higher in Warwick district compared to Coventry. It is unlikely, therefore, that people living and working in Coventry will want to buy houses on land north of Milverton. This would not help Coventry's housing need.

The Green Belt land is highly valued and sustainable for recreation purposes, e.g. walking, cycling, bird watching and running and also for educational purposes by local schools. Use of sustainable sites closer to Coventry will reduce unnecessary commuting, road congestion and harmful vehicle exhaust pollutants.

The proposed park and ride scheme is unsustainable because:

- It is unlikely to be financially viable on a daily basis. In Stratford on Avon one park & ride scheme has been closed down and the other one is closed on Sundays for part of the year.
- Users will be greatly inconvenienced without a dedicated bus service. Users will have to time visits to coincide with the bus timetables. Because there is adequate car parking in Leamington Spa shoppers are unlikely to use the park & ride. The site is too close to Leamington Spa and if there has to be a park & ride then it would be better positioned near or on the A46 roundabout with the A452 as part of the Thickthorn development.
- Much of the traffic using the A452 crosses to the south of Leamington Spa where there are major employers
