- (2) I do not believe that the proposed access point to the new development, ie via Barneshon Drive, is either safe or sained. Large vehicles, including the local bus, already struggle to mandeuvre around the traffic caining points and the likelihood of damage to both veges and pathway most be significant, should lovines and heavy plant have to enter thatton Pork from this point.
- (3) Whilst provision of schooling is no larger adjectional concern, as a famer teacher, I would have senous removers about how existing provision of school places could accommodate the proposed increase in potential mumbers and I am additionally concerned and potentially affected by the knock-on for all other associated sentces, including GP provision and local amenities. In particular, I have obvious oncern for Hatton Park Village Hall and the Children's playground next to it which would inevitably the affected by making access to the proposed development adjacent to them.
