The removal of land from the Green Belt and its allocation for development invariably gives rise to opposition from some parts of the local community - often emotional and without a rational application of national planning policy as to the reasoning why exceptional circumstances now exist to justify the exclusion of some land from the Green Belt to meet the future development needs of the District. A request is made to participate in the oral examination, so as to respond to contrary opinion that the Green Belt is tantamount to being sacrosanct; and in effect a 'no-go' area to meet housing needs of the District within the Plan period.
