I believe that Modification 16 is surround because Wennick District Council has failed to produce avidence as to why it considers that the proposed semeval of this land from the Sieen Belt falls within the Exceptional Circumstances as set out in the National Planning Policy Framework. Furthermore, the semeoval of the land would contravene the rules of precedence for the selease of land from the Sieen Belt, even if permitted Exceptional Circumstances had been demonstrated, as siles adjusent to Cavantry have been assessed as being of lower Sieen Belt value.
