Barcheston Drive is too narrow for long and heavy plant movements during the construction phase. The tus already struggles to negotiate the traffic calming features, particularly with the presence of parter cars. They may also be obliged to use grass verges and pathways presenting a danger to pedestnans and destroying the established malkways and cycle paths.
The children's play area would become dangerous as it would be next to an access road and the resultant increase in traffic to the new houses. Appropriate fences the would need to be put in place to prevent children running into the road. Also, a playground on the corner of a junction is not safe or sensible. The location of the junction is fur from ideal.
The projections for housing need in the area are tased on a thip in demand and growth will not necessarily follow the same trajectory, hence we may not need as many houses. Proposed access from the nillage hall car park is very steep. In order to pronde sufficient road infrastructure to counteract the steep gradient, additional land above that highlighted in the proposal would need to be acquired. This will impact on the nillage hall, the neighbouring play area, planted orchard, sports facilities and the number of parking spaces available for the nillage hall. Additional cur parking would also need to be provided to compensate for the loss of spaces as the proposed access is through the nillage hall car park.

The mider infrastructure (Birmingham Road) will struggle to support the additional traffic inentably generated by the occupiers of 55 homes. At peak times the road is already longested with commuters and parents driving includen to and from school.

There have been a number of fatalities and senous accidents on the Birmingham Road in recent years and an increase in traffic volume will increase the Utelihood of these occurring

The site is unsustainable environmentally us the lack of local infrastructure (public transport, schools, shops) requires additional cur use and therefore does not comply with the National Planning Policy Framework's requirement to secure sustainable development

The Local Plan has not identified the necessary infrastructure needed to support the level of new residential development for the sites allocated in the Plan, for example, new schools, health facilities and a tetter road infrastructure.
