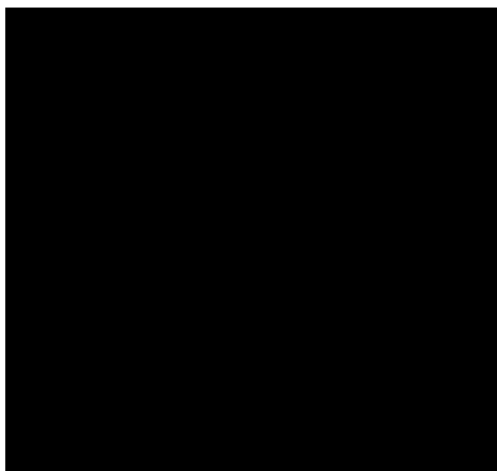

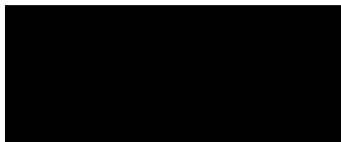

Dear Sirs  
Initially I wish to OBJECT to the revised new local plan increase of housing density (H27) which lies to the south of Auras Boulevard from 100 to 130 homes, All the allocation of Land (H51) which lies to the south of Lloyd Close for 115 homes, will the plan encourage the use of public transport, walking cycling, will it help reduce traffic congestion, does it make efficient use of existing infrastructure, i.e. Road network etc? The three roads into Hampton Magna, which reduce to a single lane in parts will become even more congested and dangerous. Will the plan protect and enhance species and habitat, will it safe guard and enhance the character of significant landscape, It will put unacceptable pressure's on existing services and community facilities, School, DOCTOR'S, HOSPITAL. Are the council "Justified" in ruling out the compulsory purchase of non-green belt sites have you considered OTHER alternatives in the green belt, that would not adversely affect existing settlements 17 hectares of land off Hampton Road, opposite Central Ajax football club was advertised for sale during the review period 2015 enough land to accommodate at least 500 homes.
