Representation on the Proposed Modification to the Submission Warwick Local Plan (2016)

This representation refers to Hatton Park. Site H28 - north of Birmingham Road and site H53 - Brownley Green Lane.

Site H28 - north of Birmingham Road.

I had submitted objections to the development of this land at the consultation stage of the Draft Local Plan. These objections in brief were:

- 1. The impact on wild life. Smiths Covert and its adjacent fields support a wide variety of wild life and should therefore be considered a wildlife sensitive location to be protected.
- 2. The additional traffic resulting from the development would at, peak times, have a significant impact on a severely congestion A4177 Birmingham Road.
- 3. These fields absorb rainfall. The housing development would significantly reduce this with the subsequent water runoff finding its way towards the Birmingham Road which is prone to flooding.

The proposed modifications to the Local Plan do little or nothing to address these objections which therefore still stand.

The original draft proposals for site H28 was for 90 dwellings. The modified plan proposes 120 new dwellings, an increase of some 33%. This level of increase suggests high density development, out of keeping and character of Hatton Park as a whole.

This additional level of development will also result in a significant increase in congestion on and onto the Birmingham Road with the resultant increase of traffic, from the new dwellings together with existing traffic, exiting Hatton Park at the most congested section of road. Hatton Park can only be exited or entered via the Birmingham Road so there is no option to avoid the congestion. This increasing congestion will also result in increasing air pollution, now acknowledged as a major cause of health problems.

This higher level of development would also lead to much higher levels of rainwater runoff and risk of flooding to the Birmingham Road.

The modified plan identifies strips of undeveloped land to the north and east of the site. This I am led to believe is to protect the ecologically sensitive areas of woodland (Smith Covert) and the hedgerow bordering the KEVII drive. This would be totally inadequate for the diversity of wild life that the woodland and adjacent fields support.

Site H53 - Brownley Green.

The development of site 53 would have merit if it were supported by a new access road into Hatton Park. Although this would have no impact on congestion levels on the Birmingham Road, or the volume of traffic exiting onto it, it would however, if suitably situated, provide a third point at which traffic exiting Hatton Park could filter onto the Birmingham Road thereby aiding traffic dispersal.
