Dear Sirs,

I strongly object to the removal of land from the Green Belt north of Milverton. Leamington and Warwick already score highly in terms of air pollution and this proposed development will make things even worse.

There are plenty of sites, including Brownhedge Site closer to Coventry to house Coventry people, who will have to commute daily back to Coventry if they work there, which most of them will have to, as employment opportunities in Leamington are limited.

This will add to further congestion on our roads, particularly the A452 to Kenilworth. → PTD

which already suffers at peak times, when traffic comes to a standstill by the old Milverton roundabout. More housing means more cars, more pollution and a further strain on our resources, here in Leamington.

Leamington Spa and Warwick are by nature country towns and not city conurbations and should not have their characters changed in this dramatic way.

The Green Belt should remain. Old Milverton will cease to retain a separate identity if this land is removed.

Wild life will suffer and the quality of life of Leamington residents will be adversely affected.
