It is unlikely that the proposed development of land north of Milverton will actually meet the objectives of the proposal. In practice people who live and work in Coventry will not be disposed to living on this land. Any park and ride scheme will be ill-conceived. Future residents will take to the roads causing more congestion on the A452 north of Leamington to the A46.
If this exercise which is deemed to fail on a practical level in fact goes ahead then the price of more congestion loss of farming land and wild life habitat and significant reduction of the local 'green lung' will be a huge one to pay.

It has not been demonstrated that exceptional circumstances exist for removing the land north of Milverton from the green belt by Warwick District Council.
The Milverton proposed development is a 'pig in the poke' solution for Coventry overspill as it is not practicable given the distance away from Coventry. The congestion on the A452 north of Leamington will be a blight for all its residents. Better solutions using lower-grade green-belt can be found elsewhere closer to Coventry. We need planning with real insight.

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The land north of Milverton should remain in the green belt. Alternative proposals should be formulated.
