The proposed development will not support Coventry City's housing need as it is unlikely that people who work to hive a work in Coventry will buy houses built there, and, more importantly, there are sustainable sites closer to Coventry that should be used in preference to the Green Belt at Milverton to reduce unrecessor commuting, viewbate congestion and more road construction.
