

Exceptional circumstances have not been demonstrated by WDC.

The proposed housing development is to support Coventry's housing need. The site is too far from Coventry to make this viable and the properties are unlikely to be bought by those who wish to work, and live, in Coventry.

Therefore ~~the~~ additional housing will need to be closer to Coventry.

There are sites on the edge of Coventry which would be far better suited to Coventry's needs. A further potential area would be close to the A46/A452 and this again would suit Coventrians far better.

There is very little green land between Kenilworth and Leamington Spa. This proposed development would further reduce this essential gap which would potentially merge the two towns with Warwick. This

It is important to ensure that this area of S.Warms is not subject to further road congestion or construction which may result from further development.

The government is keen for ~~for~~ the consumption of locally sourced food + developing this land would ~~would~~ reduce the availability of good farming land.

Similarly the Government wishes to reduce obesity, heart disease + diabetes. The land + ~~roads~~ relatively quiet road is used by those wishing to exercise. This would reduce opportunities for outdoor exercise in contravention of all the health targets that the

Government have in mind.

Similarly mental health is a priority for the Government. Accessibility to green space is an important factor in preventing mental health difficulties + ~~in easing them~~ <sup>easing others</sup>

The land is already subject to becoming water logged. When it rains the roads already begin to resemble rivers. It is high ground on which the proposed development is and water will run downhill with nowhere to go except existing housing + few remaining fields. The railway embankment could be undermined or the railway line flooded. The ~~road~~ exit from the roundabout at the Nuffield regularly floods. The area supports a wide variety

of wildlife. Owls, woodpeckers & birds  
of prey can be heard. Wildlife-all  
species will be reduced.

This is an area of relative small  
light pollution. Any development  
would reduce this.

People need to be housed close to  
where they work to avoid pollution.  
We need areas where people  
can breathe. These areas need  
to be reasonably close to where  
they live. We should not have  
to drive to the Cotswolds to  
get some fresh air.
