Having seen the proposals for the new housing said to be needed within the Leamington district, I would like to add my objections to those which you have, no doubt, already received.

In particular I am concerned about the proposal to build northward towards Headworth. This has to be an encroachment on the green belt provided between the two towns, which has already been eroded by various developments in this area.

One's immediate reaction is to wonder where the traffic will go, who is going to occupy these houses, where will there be employment for them? What about the basic requirements for large numbers of extra people in the north of the town? Schools, doctors, & real shops?

Finally this would alter the

character of Leamington as a spa town
close to the tourist attractions of Warwick,
Stratford on Avon &, further afield, the Cotswolds.
Ultimately it would need to urban spread
to meet the southern edges of Kenilworth.

Is there really need for a large
growth in the population of the town?

Where will people work that does not
involve a lot more commuter travelling
or increased industrialisation in what
is basically a pleasant, leafy country
town which we should try to preserve.
