Having seen your latest Local Plan, I would like you to consider my thoughts.

Having already had the Warwick Gates Development, I feel that South of Leamington (Whitnash area) has had more than its fair share of housing. Perhaps the time has come for North Leamington to have a share in the development of new homes - from maisonettes, semi-detached and terraced, instead of luxurious 5 bedroom properties.

- One hundred homes built in Bishops Tachbrook would add to the school being over stretched considering that at the moment, children who live in the Warwick Gates catchment area are going to school in Harbury, as their local school could not take them.

- The bus service is only one per hour and we only have one shop and one hair dresser
