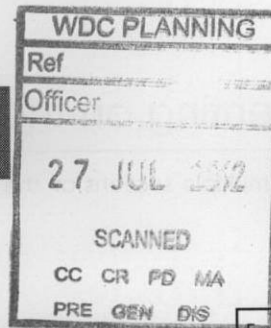

I have been looking at 'windfalls' in rural areas and it seems to me the scope is much greater proportionately than it is for urban areas. For example, the conversion proposed for Haseley Manor would add a high percentage of homes to that parish.

I think therefore there is a strong case for including windfalls within the housing allocations for rural areas (especially Green Belt villages) rather than regarding them as over and above allocations.

Otherwise there is a risk of creating a countryside scattered with houses.

I think this policy is far too inflexible.

We have a motor repair business in Hatton Green that is a considerable annoyance and danger for local residents, with cars parked very close to the B4439/Hatton Green/Dark Lane crossroads.

The owner would like to redevelop the site for housing and the local community would support this, but we are thwarted by this policy.

Could I suggest perhaps "Generally (or normally) protecting existing employment land" or "unless there is evidence that it is not suitable to accommodate projected needs, or local communities support a change of use"? This would be more in line with the NPPF as set out in your para 8.35. After all there seems little point in perpetuating a ~~non~~ non-conforming use when it is causing a nuisance and danger.

I think the Strategic Green Improvement Area around Kenilworth Castle and the Pleasance should be extended westwards to join the Wroxall Abbey / Hay Wood area & continue to include the National Trust Properties at Baddesley Clinton and Packwood.

There are a number of small woods in this area (Chase Wood, Pools Wood etc.) that can act as stepping stones along a woodland-parkland corridor that would be in accordance with the principles espoused in the Natural Environment White Paper.

A major east-west wildlife corridor would be a major asset to the District.
