PO 13 and the justification for it covers the facilities needed for safe & healthy communities – these are excellent and cover a good scope but there is one very important part missing; that is policy guidance for promotion and provision of schools.

The wording of the NPPF is as follows:

Local planning authorities should take a proactive, positive and collaborative approach to meeting this requirement, and to development that will widen choice in education. They should:

- give great weight to the need to create, expand or alter schools; and
- work with schools promoters to identify and resolve key planning issues before applications are submitted.

This wording – either verbatim or very similar – needs to be included in PO 13 with specific reference to schools; the provision of new schools – *including free schools* – and the expansion of existing schools to facilitate the education and well-being of our young.

I feel it is very important that such reference is made *in policy* to ensure its ability to be delivered.
