These submissions are directed at Part A of the Preferred Option – namely the Allocated Sites on 'the edge of Warwick Leamington Spa and Whitnash'. It is submitted that the land edged red as identified on the accompanying plan could usefully be excluded from the Green Belt and be identified as a housing site to provide greater flexibility and choice in the range of housing sites, and the geographical distribution around the principal urban area. The release of this area of land would not prejudice the following purposes of the Green Belt, namely: *To check unrestricted sprawl of large built-up areas *To prevent neighbouring towns merging into one another *To preserve the setting and special character of historic towns, and *To assist in urban regeneration by encouraging the recycling of derelict and other urban land It is acknowledged that the remaining purpose of the Green Belt is to assist safeguarding the countryside from encroachment: In the context of the need for the Local Plan to meet the 'full objectively assessed needs for market and affordable housing' (The Framework para. 47), it is concluded that the Local Plan, to be 'positively prepared' and 'justified' will need to make further provision for land suitable for new housing. Taking into account market factors and the emphasis on Garden Suburbs, will lead to lower densities being achieved. It is submitted that this site is well related to the Parkway Station and other urban facilities on the west side of Warwick. The site effectively forms part of an existing pattern of settlement to the west of the A46. The site is considered to be 'deliverable' within the meaning of paragraph 47 of The Framework.


