I am writing to protest in the strongest possible terms about the potential plans to develop & destroy Green Belt Land at Blackdown, nr. Old Milverton and at Loes Farm & the vicinity of Guy's Cliffe.

Apart from ignoring the present financial and economic crises in terms of

affordability and overloading the local infrastructure, especially in terms of roads & traffic volumes, the schemes make a chronic nonsense of previous long-standing legislative protection dating from the 1950's.

As widely reported, drastic curtailments of Greenbelt land were promoted after cliques of developers paid 100,000's of pounds into the funds of a certain political party furthermore.

Notions of creeping sprawl & coalescence make such matters even worse and in this context attention should be concentrated upon the effects of increasing

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attenuation & destruction of  
farmland at a time of  
often increasing world-wide  
food shortages & price  
increases as exemplified  
most recently in the U.S.

Reckless projects  
motivated by myopic stupidity

but recognising some housing  
may well be required it  
should be concentrated south  
of Leamington and not  
destroy designated land &  
countryside.
