We wish to object to the WDC Local Plan Preferred Options as presented in May 2012 ref/12/0641 on the following grounds;-

- 1 The plan directly compromises the Governments objective onn preserving the Green Belt where ever possible.*
- 2 The plan is compromised by "spreading the pain" where it should be what is best for area.*
- 3 The plan is compromised by being what appears to be politically possible when removing many of the traditional facilities in the northern parts of the area.*
- 4 The plan requires excessively large provision of infrastructure which currently exists in other parts of the area.*
- 5 Incursions into the Green Belt should be the last resort and not used until all possible usage of "White Land" has been utilised//*
- 6 Access to road and rail communications are not improved by the plan until the northern relief link road is constructed and new villages constructed along its route.*
